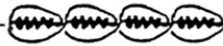

Once again, we received a robust response from local groups in Burkina Faso that are doing inspiring work to lift up and strengthen their communities. While assessing these many proposals can be time-consuming - and selecting finalists is *never* easy - each year our committee ends its review process with the same conclusion: **the spirit of *fraternité* is alive and well in the land of the upright people.**

As a result of this competitive process, four projects have been selected for FBF partnership in 2026. We are especially pleased that these projects will address essential areas of need – clean water, education, health, and agriculture – and include communities impacted by the ongoing security and humanitarian crisis.
